How can I manage leafy spurge?

- Mechanical and chemical controls are most useful and cost-effective with small or new infestations
- Biological controls are an environmentally friendly way to control spurge
- Sheep and goats will readily graze leafy spurge
- Predatory insects are used to retard spurge growth and prevent seed development
- Cultivation will control leafy spurge in cropland
